Player Expectations

- You are a student first and the athlete second. Take pride in your academic success. All
 members of the Murrieta Mesa Tennis Program must represent the program with PRIDE
 both on and off the court.
- In addition to the CIF minimum eligibility requirement of a 2.0 GPA, MMHS tennis players must adhere to the following grade requirements:
- Students who have an F grade or two or more D grades will not be permitted to dress or
 compete in that week's competition. If a student has only one D grade, they will be placed
 on probation for that week. Although they will be eligible to play in that week's competition,
 they must attend a tutoring session with coaches at a designated time, as well as a PRIDE
 period with the teacher of the D grade. The following week, if the grade does not improve,
 the student will be ineligible to participate in competition until the grade improves to a C or
 better.
- Student athletes must have passed at least 20 units of work and earned a minimum 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale during the previous grading period. In addition, student athletes understand that they are to participate in biweekly grade checks.
- If an athlete is academically ineligible at the beginning of the Fall semester, they will not be eligible to participate in tennis at all for that season, regardless of whether they participated in Spring or Summer tennis camps.
- Drugs, alcohol and all forms or tobacco use are prohibited. Any student found using drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco will be suspended from the team for a period of time as determined by the coaching staff and school administration.
- Any school discipline actions will be dealt with as the coaching staff deems necessary this
 includes detentions, suspensions, Saturday school as well as negative emails or phone calls
 from teachers or members of the community.
- Wherever you are, whenever you're there, YOU ARE ALWAYS REPRESENTING MESA TENNIS! Choose your friends wisely. Guilt by association is a common occurrence. Avoid parties/activities where alcohol and or drugs are present.
- Keep your priorities in order family, school, tennis.
- Be good teammates. Complement each other for a job well done as appropriate. Any player who disrupts the chemistry of the team and or program is subject to suspension and or dismissal from the tennis program.
